SITE Residency is a two-month creative residency hosted at The J in Noosa Junction, offering dedicated space and time for artists to deepen, disrupt, and evolve their practice. Open to artists across all disciplines, Site Residency invites you into a responsive container for experimentation, ambitious practices, and the unexpected unfolding of ideas.

This is a residency where your practice takes the lead – whether you're digging into something long dormant, refining a current body of work, or venturing into unfamiliar territory. Like the idea of a site – a place to return to, to build from, to listen to – this residency is your grounded space for transformation.

- Residents must provide their own public liability insurance for up to \$20 million

Parking & Transport


- The J offers up to 220 free on-site parking spaces
- The closest Noosa Junction bus station is approx. 560 meters from The J and a 5 minute walk. Footpath conditions are generally wheelchair-friendly with wide, flat, paved, and well-lit pathways. Available Bus Routes: 620, 622, 626, 627,628, 620, 631, 632
- Drop-off points are available via the street-level foyer/box office and the car-park entrance.

Accessibility

- Level access both via the street-level foyer/box office and the car-park entrance. Wheelchair accessible entry and interior.
- Residency space has a level access entry. Entry to outside space has a 15cm step (ramp and flooring for gravel surfaces available upon request)
- Accessible toilet within venue, approximately 9m away.
- Adjustable lights

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must:

- Be individual artists or collaborative groups. Applications are accepted from all art forms and interdisciplinary practices.
- Demonstrate a committed and considered practice—ambitious in ideas or approach—with a drive to grow and evolve their work
- Present a clear intention for the residency, outlining how they plan to use the time and space
- Be available to participate fully in the two-month residency period at The J in Noosa. An average of 3 days per week.
- Commit to delivering a residency outcome and a public program
- Be prepared to engage with the residency community and contribute to an open, exploratory creative environment.
- Please note, only four residencies are available in the 2025-2026 program.

CRITERIA

- 1. The applicant has competitively demonstrated that the residency will significantly advance their practice
- 2. The applicant's proposed residency activities demonstrate high quality and/or innovation. The following may be considered when assessing:
 - Vision, ideas, and artistic rationale
 - Level of innovation, ambition, and experimentation
 - Rigour and clear articulation of artistic and cultural processes
 - Contribution to diverse cultural expression
 - Timeliness and relevance of work
 - · Quality of previous work
- 3. The proposed Public Program offers a unique and accessible arts experience for creatives in the region.
