Noosa River Holiday Park – Small & Large Amenities Renewal

Project summary

The two amenities buildings at the Noosa River Holiday Park require renewal given their current age and condition.

Following investigation, Council has decided to completely replace the western located smaller amenities block and refurbish the larger amenities block located towards the east of the site.

Need for the work

When complete this work will:

- provide improved access for families and people with disabilities;
- utilise energy and water saving devices; and
- improve security in and around the buildings for customers.

Duration of work and proposed schedule

Construction will commence in February 2018 and is scheduled for completion in November 2018, weather permitting.

Disruption to Holiday Park customers and Munna Point beach users

Work will be staged to minimise the impact on holiday park customers and beach users by:

- locating the new small amenities block adjacent to the existing small amenities, between February and June 2018, allowing the small amenities to remain open during the construction;
- after the new small amenities has been completed, refurbish the large block, between July and November 2018; and
- demolishing the old small amenities building and the reopening of new site 32, by the end of November 2018.

Construction works are scheduled outside of key holiday user times such as the 2017/18 summer school holidays, the Easter and September School Holidays 2018.

The building contractor will use a small portion of land located between the park entrance off Russell St and the Queensland Fisheries property as a secure office/staging area during construction.
