1.0 INTRODUCTION

An infrastructure charges schedule (ICS) or a regulated infrastructure charges schedule (RICS) is a mechanism for funding the supply of trunk infrastructure identified in a priority infrastructure plan.

The *State Planning Regulatory Provision (adopted charges)* (SPRP) supersedes the infrastructure charging components of the PIP.

Adopted infrastructure charges are issued in accordance with the SPRP and Council's Adopted Infrastructure Charges Resolution.
