

# FACTSHEET: Trucks

**To help keep our residential streets accessible, restrictions apply to long-term truck and heavy or long vehicle parking.**

A heavy vehicle, or long vehicle, must not stop on a length of road in a built up area for longer than 1 hour.

A heavy vehicle must not be driven through or stopped within an off-street regulated parking area.

A long vehicle is defined in TORUM (Transport Operations [Road Use Management] Act 1995) Section 127 as any one of the following:-

- A vehicle or trailer that is longer than 7.5 metres.
- A vehicle or trailer where any load or projection is longer than 7.5 metres
- Any combination which is 7.5 metres long or longer
- Any component of a combination (a prime mover or prime mover trailer), which if standing alone is 5 metres or longer

A heavy vehicle is defined under TORUM Section 200 as any one of the following:-

- Any component of a heavy vehicle with a Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) of 4.5 tonnes or more
- Any other vehicle with a GVM of 4.5 tonnes or more

## Exemption

Trucks that have broken down are exempt from this restriction but only for the minimum time necessary to make minor repairs that would allow the vehicle to be moved to a place where it is lawfully parked.

Other exemptions include vehicles:

- Carrying out emergency works
- Delivery goods or providing services to the area

## Enforcement

Noosa Council Officers will enforce this legislation. Failure to comply may result in an infringement notice with 2 Penalty units
