Construction of accessible bus stop - Orient Drive, Sunrise Beach

Project summary

Work has commenced on this year's bus stop programme. Federal legislation requires all public transport bus stops must meet disability compliance standards by December 2022.

Work is set to commence on the bus stop near Beach Access 38 on Orient Drive. The works will include a new concrete boarding platform, incorporating a new bus seat and bin.

Funding

The Queensland Government's Passenger Transport Accessible Infrastructure Program provides funding assistance to councils to help them achieve compliance. The funding ratio is currently dollar for dollar.

Noosa Council has allocated \$500,000 in this year's capital works programme including \$225,000 funding from State Government.

Funding limits the scope of work and does not permit installation of a shelter if none already exists.

Duration of work

Work at this bus stop is scheduled to commence early February and is expected to be completed in 3 weeks, weather dependent.

Disruption to bus passengers

This bus stop will close temporarily during the work. A temporary stop will be operational adjacent to the works.
