### Peregian Beach Village & Foreshore Infrastructure Upgrades

Peregian Beach will benefit from three infrastructure projects to enhance the social hub of the village and foreshore to commence in 2019.

#### Project summaries

- **Peregian Beach Public Amenities Block**

A new larger public amenities building will replace the current facility, next to Kingfisher Drive and south of the surf club.

The new design aims to maintain the majority of the established trees at the site and limit the visual impact of the waste compound which is to be relocated to enhance the streetscape.

- **Boardwalk between SLSQ Tower and Beach Access 57**

Proposed upgrade works to the boardwalk north of Beach Access 57 include:

- A 10m extension of concrete beach access
- Relocation of the northern beach shower away from the upgraded boardwalk
- At the closed boardwalk section, construct a viewing platform or replace with 50m of new boardwalk, and
- Sand dune regeneration.

- **Peregian Beach Town Square Upgrade**

Town square upgrade works are being designed for review with the Town Square businesses and local community in November. These works include:

- Improved pedestrian access, and
- Drainage improvements.

#### Timeframes

To avoid disruption during the peak tourism seasons and construct during the more traditionally dry period, construction will commence in May 2019 on the new amenities block, boardwalk and shower facility.
