David Low Way and Heron St Peregian Beach

Project summary

Work will commence shortly to remove a Cottonwood tree, growing in a restricted space, on the corner of David Low Way and Heron Street.

Project Scope

Removal of the Cottonwood tree, which is completely covering the street light, will:

- allow the two remaining trees to thrive in increased growing space
- improve the effectiveness of corner street lighting for pedestrians and motorists.

Pruning of the tree, if carried out, would lead to a poorly structured tree at risk of failure.

Scheduled works

Council contractors will carry out the work in one day on Monday, 4 February, weather permitting.

Disruption will be minimised with work beginning early.

Replacement trees and offsets

As per Council's Tree Management on Public Land policy, a suitable replacement tree will be planted in nearby Peregian Beach Park.
