#### **Title**

1. This notice may be cited as Noosa Shire Council (Making of Local Law) Website Notice (No. 2) 2018.

### Making of local law

- 2. Noosa Shire Council (the "Council") has, by resolution dated 16 August 2018, made—
  - (a) Administration and Other Local Laws (Amendment) Local Law (No. 1) 2018 (the "new local law"); and
  - (b) Administration and Other Subordinate Local Laws (Amendment) Subordinate Local Law (No. 1) 2018 (the "new subordinate local law").

#### Purpose and general effect of local law

- 3. The purpose and general effect of the new local law is as follows—
  - (a) the new local law, part 2, regulates the operation of accommodation parks; and
  - (b) the new local law, part 3, amends *Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management)* 2015; and
  - (c) the new local law, part 4, deals with the protection of vegetation on local government controlled areas and roads.

#### Purpose and general effect of subordinate local law

- 4. The purpose and general effect of the new subordinate local law is as follows—
  - (a) the new subordinate local law, part 2—
    - (i) applies the authorising local law to State-controlled roads in Council's local government area; and
    - (ii) regulates the installation of advertising devices, and in particular, election signs; and
    - (iii) regulates the operation of accommodation parks; and
    - (iv) regulates the operation of shared facility accommodation; and
  - (b) the new subordinate local law, part 3, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2015; and
  - (c) the new subordinate local law, part 4, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2015; and

- (d) the new subordinate local law, part 5, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015; and
- (e) the new subordinate local law, part 6, amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2015* by the declaration of off-street regulated parking areas.

## **Existing local laws amended**

- 5. The new local law amends existing local laws of Council as follows—
  - (a) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2015;
  - (b) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2015;
  - (c) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015.

## Existing subordinate local laws amended

- 6. The new subordinate local law amends existing subordinate local laws of Council as follows—
  - (a) the new subordinate local law, part 2, amends *Subordinate Local Law No. 1 (Administration)* 2015:
  - (b) the new subordinate local law, part 3, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2015;
  - (c) the new subordinate local law, part 4, amends Subordinate Local Law No .3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2015;
  - (d) the new subordinate local law, part 5, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015;
  - (e) the new subordinate local law, part 6, amends Subordinate Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2015.

#### **Authorising local law**

- 7. Various local laws of Council authorise the making of the new subordinate local law as follows—
  - (a) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 1 (Administration) 2015 authorises the making of the new subordinate local law, part 2;
  - (b) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2015 authorises the making of the new subordinate local law, part 3;
  - (c) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 3 (Community and Environmental Management) 2015 authorises the making of the new subordinate local law, part 4;
  - (d) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 4 (Local Government Controlled Areas, Facilities and Roads) 2015 authorises the making of the new subordinate local law, part 5;
  - (e) Noosa Shire Council Local Law No. 5 (Parking) 2015 authorises the making of the new subordinate local law, part 6.

# **Anti-competitive provisions**

8. Each of the new local law and the new subordinate local law contain anti-competitive provisions.

# Inspection

- 9. Copies of the new local law and the new subordinate local law may be—
  - (a) inspected and purchased at Council's public office and viewed by the public on the website of Council; and
  - (b) viewed by the public on the website of the Department of Local Government.
