## **NO GARDEN WASTE ALLOWED**

The Noosa kerbside rubbish collection is for private houses and unit complexes (NOT commercial). Collection is ideal for bulky items such as discarded white goods, furniture and electronic equipment generally used in households. There are however some limitations:

#### All items of rubbish



Must be capable of being loaded by two employees;

Large items should be reduced in size;



Loose (small) rubbish items must be boxed.

# The collection will NOT accept:

- Excess quantities or items incorrectly placed on footpath
- Loose rubbish (not boxed)
- Batteries, tyres, oils, petrol, etc.
- Gas bottles, oil filled heaters, flammable items
- Asbestos (fibro), soil, stones or sand
- Chemicals or paint (tins must be empty)
- Garden waste
- Tree trunks or stumps
- Material or items in excess of two metres in length/height or width
- Heavy materials i.e. items not capable of being loaded by two employees
- Fire extinguishers and flares
- Mattresses (unless prepaid refer to mattress collection details on this page)

### **Kerbside recycling:**

Some items may be taken by community groups, charities or someone who finds them useful. Such recycling initiatives are not controlled by Council.

Anyone taking items for re-use should leave the balance neatly stored for collection, take care to avoid injury to themselves or others while removing items and be aware that discarded items may be contaminated or potentially harmful.
