

Deferred Payments of Infrastructure Charges on Development due to COVID-19

In accordance with Council's **COVID-19 Business Support Initiatives** dated 26 March 2020, infrastructure charges may be deferred until July 2021 with no interest payments applied.

Eligibility: All developments are eligible for this initiative.

Dates: Payment to Council is deferred to the sooner of:

- 1 July 2021; or
- prior to any sale of (or part of) the completed development.

Process: To take advantage of this offer, applicants should send a request to defer payment of the applicable infrastructure charge by email to:
ic@noosa.qld.gov.au

Requests should be made:

- **ONLY** for those Developments when they approach completion; and
- provide the Development Approval, Infrastructure Charge Notice & Property address reference/s.

Council will then issue an “*Infrastructure Charges Notice of Amount Due*” confirming the amount payable with the Due Date For Making Payment deferred to 1 July 2021 but prior to any sale of (or part of) the completed development.

Further Delayed Staged Payments may also be permitted on separate written application to Council. Refer to “Delayed Staged Payments” information on the “Infrastructure Charges” page of Council’s website.
