Introduction

This grant aims to provide 'quick response' financial assistance to eligible community organisations that are either experiencing financial hardship as a result of COVID-19 related service disruptions; seeking to establish alternate service delivery models for business continuity; or seeking to provide support services to vulnerable residents impacted by COVID-19.

You will choose one of the three streams of this funding:

- **HARDSHIP** - Direct financial assistance to community organisations experiencing hardship due to the impacts of COVID-19 or;
- **ALTERNATE SERVICE MODELS** - Operational projects that support community organisations to continue the delivery of services via alternate service delivery models or;
- **SERVICES TO VULNERABLE RESIDENTS** - Projects that support the delivery of services to vulnerable residents impacted by COVID-19.

Assessment

Applications will be assessed considering the following criteria:

- Value for money
- Demonstrated need for funding
- Benefit to the community
- Engagement of local suppliers where applicable/possible
- Validity of claim
- The amount of funding available.

Only one grant application per organisation can be submitted.
