Noosa Council is inviting interested parties (must have an ABN) to lodge an expression of interest to hold relevant activities across Climate Week. Council has a small budget for this event and is able to provide funding from \$500 to \$1000 for each activity to undertake these events. Specifically Council is seeking activities that will appeal to participants across a wide variety of sectors including, but not limited to:

- Households – owned and tenanted
- Businesses
- Tourists
- Children
- Youth and Schools
- Agriculture
- Older people
- Biodiversity/nature

Activities should address specific issues related to climate change including, but not limited to:

- Energy efficiency
- Renewable energy
- Zero emission transport options
- Carbon drawdown
- Waste reduction and the circular economy
- Climate advocacy
- Climate adaptation and resilience

Each EOI will be assessed on its merits and consider the following:

- The relevance of the activity in addressing Climate Change
- The target audience
- Value for Money
