Hinterland Adventure Playground construction

Noosa Council is creating a nature-based, all-abilities destination that will inspire the imagination of children and adults alike. This iconic destination will encourage more visitors to the hinterland, with the added bonus of creating employment opportunities and helping to boost the local economy.

The project is a joint initiative of Noosa Council and the Queensland Government.

Key features

Key features include:

- open green space to play and relax
- nature exploration areas including a sensory garden
- replicated creek waterplay area
- natural climbing structures, including a flying fox adjacent to the existing creek
- public toilet building
- functional elements such as seating, picnic shelters, and BBQs
- landscaping and architecture that is sympathetic to the surrounding environment and infrastructure, such as the Cooroy Library and Mill District.

What you need to know

After years of planning and development, construction of the new playground will start in April and will be finished by the end of 2021, weather permitting.

Timeline

April 2021

Final detailed design and start of playground construction

December 2021

Playground construction complete, weather permitting

February 2021

Award of design and construct contract to Aspect Contractors

Sept 2021

Carparks and road safety improvements complete, weather permitting
