Peregian Beach Boardwalk Renewal

Project update

Noosa Council is pleased to advise construction works to upgrade the Peregian Beach Foreshore will commence in late May. The upgrade will deliver 40m of wheelchair friendly boardwalk reconnecting Beach Access 57 to Beach Access 58 as well as providing a new beach shower facility.

Improvements to the boardwalk will benefit the community and provide much improved access for surf lifesaving staff by addressing issues posed by the uneven surface of the current boardwalk including reduced wheelchair accessibility.

Providing new beach shower facilities will also help cater to the high demand at this very popular Peregian Beach location.

Revegetation of exposed areas will be conducted as part of the project works.

The \$230,000 project is funded under the Queensland Government's Unite and Recover Fund.

Access and community impacts

Construction is expected to take one month, weather permitting. Works will be undertaken Monday to Friday so as not to impact regular community events or peak usage times of the playground and facilities during the weekend. The works are expected to have minimal impact on public access.
