

### Sobraon Street slope stabilisation, Sunrise Beach

#### Project update

Council is pleased to advise construction of the Sobraon Street slope stabilisation project is starting in early June.

Construction by PCA Ground Engineering will take approximately seven weeks to complete, weather permitting.

The project aims to stabilise the slope while minimising the impact to the existing vegetated slope and surrounding areas. Impacted areas will be revegetated following stabilisation works.

These works are vital to maintain the long-term serviceability of the road.

This project is jointly funded under the Federal Government's Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program and the Queensland Government's COVID Works for Queensland program.

#### Traffic and community impacts

Given the proximity of the work to adjacent properties, there may be some short-term impacts while construction is underway.

Nearby residents may experience some additional noise and vibration during work. This will be limited to daytime hours only.

The current one-way traffic arrangement and 22.5 tonne load limit will remain in place until work is complete.

During work hours, traffic control will direct motorists through the work site. The road will be re-opened to one-way traffic outside work hours.

Pedestrians are encouraged to use an alternative route to avoid machinery and increased heavy vehicle traffic.

Council appreciates the community's patience while this important project is underway.
