### **WILSON PEE-WEE (AGE 4-7) 30 MINUTE LESSON**

Designed for the little ones just starting out. Soft balls, short nets and small racquets bring the game down to their level allowing easier success and enjoyment. Pee Wee classes have no more than 4 kids per coach. The cost is \$115.00 per term.

### **JUNIOR ROOKIE (AGE 7-9) 1 HOUR LESSON**

After achieving the concept of control and the basic understanding of the different strokes in the Pee-Wee program, the children use the large net using green dot balls and playing from 3/4 court.

In this program the emphasis is now on the children's technique which will stay with them no matter how far they take their tennis. The introduction of match play, scoring and tennis etiquette is also achieved in this program. The cost is \$160.00 per term.

### **JUNIOR PRO (9 -16) MATCH PLAY - 60 MINUTE LESSON**

In this stage of the program we concentrate on developing and fine tuning the skills learnt from the Junior Rookie program. From here, there is more emphasis on serving, as the children are developing their match play skills. The nice thing about this program is that older teenagers, playing tennis for the fun of the game can take these skills throughout their life as a social game. The cost is \$160.00 per term.

### **ELITE & FIXTURES SQUAD TRAINING (TOURNAMENT & FIXTURES PLAYERS) 2 HOUR LESSONS**

Complete training for the competitive/fixtures/tournament players. Fitness, court strategies, equipment and mental consideration are all considered in this program. Here the students are training to become reliable and effective with their game under the pressures of match play. It is here where they prepare the students to play fixtures, tournaments and senior fixtures. The cost is \$250.00 per term.

## WHERE ARE WE?

The Tewantin Tennis Club is situated within the Noosa District Sports Complex, with an entrance off McKinnon Drive, Tewantin (on the road to Boreen Point). There are ten artificial grass courts which are located well off the road in an attractive tree-lined setting.



## VISITORS

Visitors are most welcome to join in the regular weekly social tennis sessions for a fee of \$7 per session (including complimentary tea/coffee).

For those who intend to play often, and who stay long enough, the purchase of a Monthly Visitor's Card for \$40 a month allows the holder to play in the social tennis sessions without paying the normal Visitor's fee.

## MEMBERSHIP

*The 2021 annual fee for Juniors is \$60.*

*Adult memberships for parents of Junior members are available for a significantly discounted fee (50%).*

The Tewantin Tennis Club is affiliated with Tennis Queensland, so membership includes TQ registration which entitles members to insurance cover for any sports injury while playing tennis at the Club.

Members can join in the regular weekly social tennis sessions with no additional playing fees.

Members are entitled to use the courts for private play subject to availability. Bookings are made using the Book A Court program on our website under "Court Hire".

There is no cost during the day and a fee of \$2/hour for play under lights at night.

Members may invite guests to join them for private play with guest's fees of \$7/hour during the day and \$9/hour for play under lights at night.

*Members are responsible for collecting their guest's playing fees if they have not been paid through Book A Court.*

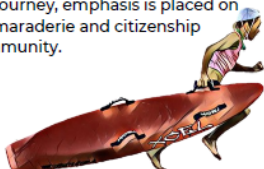

## ABOUT OUR PROGRAM

Nippers was established at the Noosa Heads Surf Lifesaving Club in 1967. With over 50 years of experience, we have grown to be the largest nippers program in Queensland. The program runs across both Noosa Heads and Peregrine Beach. This gives families the flexibility of two different beach conditions. Peregrine Beach has a small welcoming community. Noosa Heads provides more sheltered conditions and an awesome competitive edge. Both locations have the same program, a family-friendly environment, and value for money.

Not only is junior activities a fun way for children to enjoy the beach in a safe environment, but it also offers an educational pathway through the delivery of the SLSC Junior Development Program. The program is designed to ensure children have fun at the beach while participating in lessons that will provide them with a pathway to become a fully rounded participant in both lifesaving and sports activities. The program includes a wide range of subjects and skills relative to the aquatic environment and prepares Nippers for their transition to becoming an Active patrolling member. Throughout their Nippers and lifesaving journey, emphasis is placed on the spirit of camaraderie and citizenship within the community.



## HOW TO BECOME A NIPPER



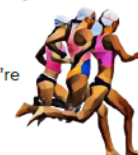
Nippers is open to children from 5 up to 13\*. Nippers isn't just for the littlies. Parents and guardians are encouraged to take up a supporting role, such as Age Managers, Water safety, Officials, Parent Liaisons, and many more to support their children's involvement.

The Nippers safety is our number one priority. To ensure each and every child has the necessary aquatic skills to participate safely in the ocean, there is an expectation that all participants will complete a junior preliminary skills evaluation prior to commencing the program. Nippers is not a swimming skills program, each child will enjoy the benefits of Nippers a lot more if they can swim and are confident in the water.

\*Age Group for a season is calculated as of midnight 30 September.

## WHAT HAPPENS AT NIPPERS?

Nippers is not about teaching children to swim. We instead focus on survival and rescue skills that are so valuable to children who live in close proximity to many beaches and waterways. Nippers is focused on play, participation, and fun. It offers an educational pathway to become a knowledgeable participant in both lifesaving and sport. When you join you have the opportunity to gain surf skills in both areas through the Sunday junior activities program, and also can access mid-week training sessions to develop skills in competition. Not only will you meet new friends and learn new skills, but you will also become part of an iconic organization that has served the Australian community for over 100 years. ### UNIFORMS

Nippers are required to wear their designated colored nipper cap and pink hi-vis singlet during every Sunday session. Club togs are optional on Nipper Sundays; however, they are compulsory if nippers wish to compete. The nippers uniform shop is located in the members forecourt and is open from 7 am each nippers Sunday. Please note that loan uniforms are available on sign-in / sign-out and are washed weekly due to COVID restrictions.

### CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

All members in supporting roles have to complete a 'Child and youth risk management strategy' (CYRMS). This is in accordance with the Working with Children (Risk Management and Screening) Act 2000. All parents wishing to participate as supporting roles MUST hold a current Working with Childrens BlueCard.
