## Bug lady speaks at forum

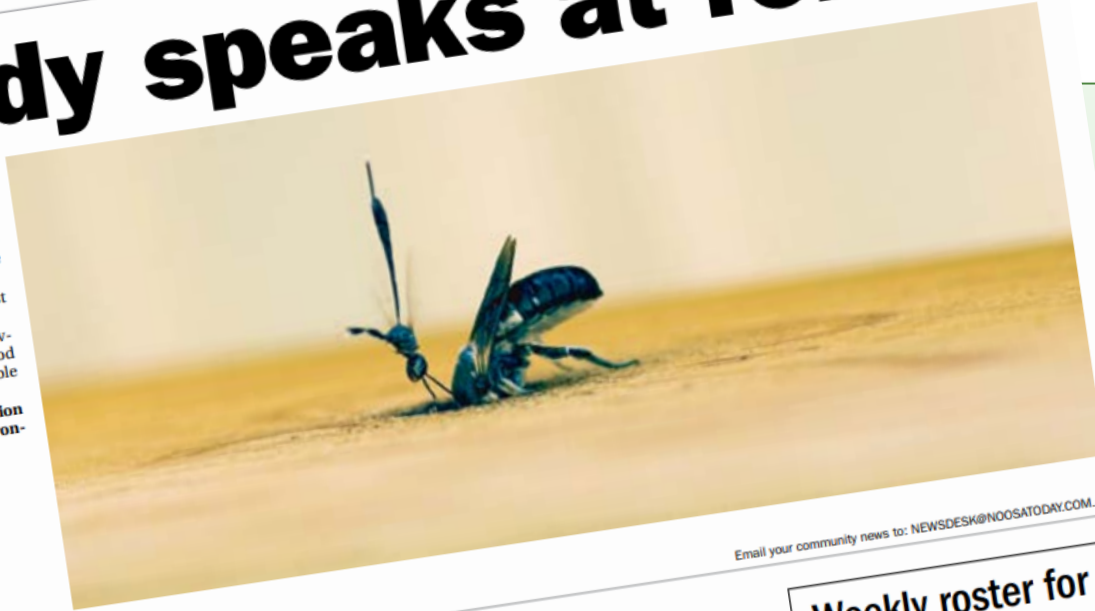
The Friday Environment Forum at Noosa Parks Association, The Days of our Hives forum with Michelle Gleeson, has been moved from 9 July to 16 July.

- New grant category in addition to other grants
- Reducing Emissions to achieve net zero emissions by 2026
- Assisting the community become more resilient to the impacts of climate change over time
- Address one or more of the themes in the recently endorsed Climate Change Response Plan
  - i. Leadership and governance
  - ii. Energy efficiency and governance
  - iii. Clean low emissions industries
  - iv. Sustainable transport
  - v. Health & resilient natural systems and carbon sequestration and food systems
  - vi. Sustainable agriculture
    - vii. Resilient and adaptive communities and built environments
  - viii. Zero waste and circular economies

**1 January - 31 December 2022**

### **How much can be funded?**

**Project Grant - minimum \$1,000, maximum \$30,000**

**RADF Grant - minimum \$1,000, maximum \$5,000**
