- Are considered likely to disrupt, provoke, attack or offend others;
- Are racist, sexist, homophobic, sexually explicit, abusive or otherwise objectionable;
- Contain profanity or other language likely to offend;
- Could break the law or condone or encourage unlawful activity (this includes breach of copyright, defamation and contempt of court);
- Are seen to impersonate someone else;
- Include contact details such as phone numbers, postal or email addresses;
- Describe or encourage activities which could endanger the safety of well-being of others:
- Are considered to be 'spam' (posts containing the same message posted multiple times);
- Are repeatedly off-topic for the discussion to which you are posting;
- Do not relate directly to Noosa Council's services, programs or enquiries;
- Are purely commercial in nature and promote a product or service which does not relate to Noosa Council or its facilities.
