Ross Crescent Slope Stabilisation, Sunshine Beach

Project update

Remediation work is required at Ross Crescent due to evidence of slope instability within the adjacent dune area. This is a result of the recent rain events, loose sandy material, and the steep topography of the site.

Council has engaged contractors to help divert water away from the base of the slope to prevent further slips and geotechnical experts have been engaged to prepare plans to stabilise the slope. Contractors are now completing the slope remediation works by driving sand nails into the slope to stabilise the dune area.

Council is investigating and developing a long-term geotechnical solution. It is expected this work will be completed in 2022 and will provide a permanent solution.

This work is vital to maintaining the long-term serviceability of the footpath area and help prevent further slippage.

Project timing

The current remediation work will continue until Thursday 23 December and then recommence on Tuesday 5 January 2022, taking approximately two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Due to the emergent nature of the project, work will continue over the weekend of 8 and 9 January 2022.

Footpath and community impacts

The footpath area between Sobraon Street and Ross Crescent will be closed whilst remediation work continues as this is an active construction site. Detours with signage directing pedestrians will be in place including the informal beach access paths. However, the footpath area will be open over the Christmas period for pedestrians.

Residents may experience some noise impact whilst the machinery is in operation, however, this will be kept to a minimum where possible.
