Noosa Parade corridor upgrade, Noosa Heads Stage 1 update

Project update

Stage 1 of the Noosa Parade corridor upgrade is progressing well with construction of the new median between the Munna Point Bridge and Lagoona Drive nearing completion.

Footpath and driveway work

Following completion of the new median, work will move on to the northern footpath and verge area.

This work will impact some residents and businesses while the kerb profiling and reconstruction is underway. Bellwether Contractors have contacted residents whose property access will be impacted, with further contact to be made the day before work starts.



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Traffic impacts

Moving the work area to the northern footpath and verge will see the active traffic lane move across to run alongside the newly completed median section.

Motorists are advised to drive to the changed conditions, follow signage, and allow additional travel time. Short-term lane closures may also be required while work is underway, with traffic control who will direct traffic.

For the safety of workers who are in close proximity to live traffic, all motorists are reminded to adhere to the reduced speed limit of 40km/h. We appreciate your patience and cooperation while these important works are underway.
