Noosa Parade corridor upgrade, Noosa Heads - Stage 1 update

After the Easter long weekend, construction on Stage 1 of the Noosa Parade corridor upgrade, between Munna Point Bridge and Lagoona Drive, will focus on the new pathways and property crossovers.

New shared pathways

Construction of the upgraded pathways on each side of the road will be completed over consecutive weeks to maintain safe access for pedestrians, bike riders, and other road users while work is underway.

- Between 19 April and 3 May 2022, the new southern pathway will be constructed. A signed detour will direct pedestrians onto the northern pathway.
- Work on the northern pathway will follow, starting on 3 May until 31 May 2022. A signed detour will direct pedestrians onto the southern pathway.

Maps illustrating the detour routes during the pathway closures are on page 2.

New property crossovers

New crossovers for properties with direct access onto Noosa Parade will be constructed at the same time as the new pathways during April and May.

During the design phase of the project, Council advised all property owners about the new crossovers and impacts for individual properties.

Access to properties will be impacted while new crossovers are constructed. Bellwether Contractors will contact all property owners and residents directly in advance of work starting so alternative arrangements can be made.

The timing of all works is weather and construction conditions permitting.

Traffic and community impacts

Motorists are reminded to drive to the changed conditions, comply with the reduced speed limit, follow signage, and allow additional travel time.

Short-term lane closures may also be required while work is underway, with traffic control directing traffic.

With changed arrangements for pedestrian and bike riders, motorists are encouraged to pay extra attention along Noosa Parade when this work is underway.

During the construction of the new pathways, the "Quamby Place" bus stop on Noosa Parade will be closed, with the "Key Court" stop being the nearest alternative stop location.
