Noosa River dredging program

Project update

Council has appointed a dredging contractor, Nabis Dredging to undertake nourishment activities along the foreshore and revetment wall areas of the Noosa River.

These areas have been identified as they have experienced significant erosion due to recent extreme weather events in February and May. Some flood impacted areas along Gympie Terrace have already been completed as part of the dredging program which is currently undertaking works at Munna Point foreshore.



Impact of works

Dredging is conducted during daylight hours with foreshore areas cordoned off whilst works are undertaken. Works have a minimal impact on foreshore users.

Upcoming dredging activities

Between July and December this year, dredging activities will be focused on the remaining areas of Gympie Terrace foreshore, including revetment walls and the Hilton Terrace foreshore.

Over the three years of the current dredging contract, dredging and renourishing activities will be conducted at various Noosa River foreshore locations and Noosa Sound.

Dredging activities are only permitted in areas where Council has environmental permits.
