Sobraon Street Sunrise Beach, Slope Remediation

Summary

During an intense rainfall event earlier this year, damage occurred to a small section of the sandy slope near the lower section of Sobraon Street at Sunrise Beach.

Temporary Works

Temporary protection work and additional rock placement has been undertaken to limit further damage to the road whilst the long term remediation planning and design is undertaken.

Future Works

Stormwater

To enable a resilient slope remediation, Council must construct a section of new underground stormwater pipe to divert flow away from the slope. Construction is planned to commence early September and will take approximately 3 weeks to complete.

Slope Remediation

A concept design has been completed for the slope repair. This design provides a repair treatment that can be construction in a relatively short period of time.

Council is working to finalise a detailed design and engage a contractor to perform the work. Whilst we cannot provide construction dates as yet, this work will be undertaken as a priority as soon as possible following the associated stormwater diversion work.

Impact

The lower section of Sobraon Street will remain closed to through traffic until the stormwater and slope work is completed.

Some minor traffic interruptions may be required during the stormwater construction operations along Vernon Street. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist as required.

Additional stormwater flow may be observed along the roadway during heavy periods of rain while temporary diversions are in place.
