### Noosa Parade corridor upgrade, Noosa Heads Progress update

Asphalting and the installation of temporary lane markers on Noosa Parade will start on the evening of Sunday, 11 September 2022 between the Munna Point Bridge and Garth Prowd bridges. This nightwork is being completed as part of the Noosa Parade corridor upgrade.

Asphalting and installing temporary lane markers will take about two weeks, weather and construction conditions permitting. Unlike other activities on this project that were completed in stages, asphalting along the full length of the project will assist in fast tracking completion.

#### On-street parking changes

All on-street parking bays along Noosa Parade between the Munna Point Bridge and the Garth Prowd Bridge must be removed to allow for the road surface to be replaced. The parking will be removed from 5pm, Friday 9 September 2022.

If you usually park a vehicle or boat trailer in this section of Noosa Parade, you will need to make alternate arrangements while construction is underway. Vehicles in the work zone will be towed. Motorists are encouraged to use on-street parking in adjoining side streets.

#### Traffic and community impacts

**Work hours:** Asphalting will be completed between Sundays and Thursdays, 6pm – 6am.

**Traffic control:** During nightworks, traffic will be reduced to one lane while asphalting is completed.

Localised traffic changes will include reduced speed limits, traffic control, and short-term disruptions. Motorists are advised to drive to the changed conditions, follow signage, and allow additional travel time.

Both lanes of traffic will re-open during the day.

**Audible noise and dust:** Audible noise and possible dust from construction activities and heavy machinery may be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during work hours.

**Lighting:** Lighting towers will be used to light the work area. This is necessary to ensure the safety of workers and motorists.
