Maintenance Grading Work - various locations

Project Summary

Maintenance grading activities continue on local gravel roads. Roads will be inspected prior to the start of work and maintenance carried out in sections based on the required grading treatment. Grading is conducted to repair potholes, corrugations and to improve drainage, improving our road networks for all users.

Please note that some of these roads will have been affected by the disaster event in February and March 2022 and those repairs are outside the scope of our maintenance grading activities and will be undertaken once approval has been granted.

Grading works commenced 17 October. The work will take place between 6:30am and 3:30pm, subject to favourable weather and operational conditions.

Traffic impacts

Traffic will be slowed and redirected into one lane through the work zone whilst grading activities take place.

Traffic control will be in place to ensure the safety of motorists and we ask that drivers obey the instructions of traffic control staff when travelling through active work sites.
