Landslip Repair – Flood Event 2022



This document outlines the locations and the progress of the reconstruction efforts. These have been split into phases to help group the tasks to demonstrate progress towards completed reconstruction:

Phase 1: Landslips require geotechnical engineering to determine slope stability which will inform the remediation works required. All sites will also require survey work to help develop the design.
Phase 2: Submission to the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) to gain approved funding from the Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements (DRFA). Timing of submission may need to wait until the funding grant is released by QRA.

Phase 3: Design and environmental approvals.
