Ed Webb Park, Sunshine Beach – Pathway and Erosion Improvements

Project Summary

Drainage and pathway improvements to reduce erosion, improve stormwater quality, and enhance pedestrian safety and connectivity between local businesses, the beach and the Sunshine Beach Surf Club are planned for Ed Webb Park.

Project scope

Council will install new pathways along the park's boundaries on Webb Road and Duke Street to improve pedestrian safety. The pathway access ramps at the Sunshine Beach Surf Club car park will be realigned to make crossing the road from the park to the beach easier and more accessible. The new pathway will encourage pedestrians to avoid walking on the road. A new pathway at the top section of the park on Webb Road will improve accessibility and help to direct stormwater away from the park.

New decking, seating, retaining walls and shade-tolerant turf will help stabilise the slope and improve stormwater quality, whilst improving the park's usability and amenity.

Existing healthy trees will be retained. However, the arborist has identified that one tree will be removed from the amphitheatre.

Existing shelters and BBQs will be relocated to make room for a new lawn amphitheatre.

The final design is subject to change due to funding, site investigations and availability of materials (concept design overleaf).

Timeline

15 January 2022 Community feedback closes

> Mid 2023 Construction starts

Early December

Ed Webb Park concept drainage and pathway improvements distributed to the community

March 2023 Tender awarded

Late 2023 Construction complete

Community Impact

Ed Webb Park will be closed for approximately three months during construction.

Access to the beach, playground and amenities will remain open during the works.

Parking will be reconfigured slightly to accommodate the new pathway on Webb Road. However, there will be no loss of parking.

Council will keep the community updated as the project progresses.
