

Middle Creek Road, Federal - road improvements

Project summary

Road works to improve safety will soon take place on Middle Creek Road, Federal between Federal State School and Andersons Road.

Works will include:

- widening and sealing of road shoulders to 6 metres
- lime stabilisation of subgrade
- regrading of table drains
- line marking and signage improvements.

Timing

Works are scheduled to commence **9 January 2023**. It is anticipated that the works will take approximately three months to complete.

The start date and estimated construction timeframe are subject to favourable weather conditions, contractor and product availability.

Community impact

Middle Creek Road will remain open for the duration of works and traffic control will be in place where required.

Localised traffic changes will include reduced speed limits, traffic control, and short-term disruptions. Motorists are advised to drive to the changed conditions, follow signage, and allow additional travel time.

Council is conscious of the additional traffic use on Middle Creek Road while the Black Mountain Road landslide is being repaired. The upgrade

of Middle Creek Road will provide a safer route for vehicles once completed and all efforts will be made to minimise the disruptions during these upgrade works.

Audible noise and dust: Audible noise and possible dust from construction activities and heavy machinery may be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during work hours.

Your patience during these works is appreciated.

Funding

The Middle Creek Road Rehabilitation project was made possible through \$1,292,692 funding from the Australian Government through the Local Roads and Community Infrastructure Program. This program supports local councils to deliver priority local road and community infrastructure projects across Australia.
