

## Noosa Waters Lock and Weir Renewal – Stage 1

### Project summary

Renewal works on the 30-year-old lock and weir system at the Noosa Waters canal estate will be undertaken this year.

Works will include:

- replacement of the lock gates and motors
- concrete repairs and replacement of corroded handrails, fixtures and fittings
- cleaning of the lock chamber and weir screen
- repairs/replacement of the southern and northern pontoon jetties
- repairs to the salinity exchange system intake and outtake jetties.

Prior to these works and to inform the detailed design of renewal works, a site inspection, 3D scan and cleaning of the bulk head guides will be undertaken as part of Stage 1.

### Timeline – Stage 1

Works on Stage 1 will be undertaken from **Tuesday 14 February until Thursday 23 February**, subject to contractor and material availability and weather.

### Community impacts

While Stage 1 works are being completed, boating vessels will be unable to transit between the Noosa River entry canal and the estate canals.
