Kin Kin, Golden Gully Road – reconstruction complete

Overview of the works

Reconstruction of the three sites included:

- Establishing and maintaining temporary sidetracks to keep local access for the duration of the works.
- Demolition and disposal of damaged drainage structures.
- Installing reinforced concrete including aprons, headwalls, and batter protection.
- Inlet and outlet shaping and rock protection.

Project summary

Three locations on Golden Gully Road at Kin Kin required reconstruction after sustaining flood damage during the significant rainfall in early 2022. Two water crossings had scouring requiring repairs.

Reconstruction provided an opportunity to construct more resilient road infrastructure, as well as improving the waterway design required by Department of Agriculture and Fisheries. With work to reconstruct this area now complete, the road has been restored to normal operation.

We would like to thank residents and motorists for their patience and understanding while these works were completed.
