Ridgewood, Old Ceylon Road

Project update

The 2022 flooding event caused significant damage on Old Ceylon Road, with multiple landslides and slumps impacting the stability of the slope near 130 Old Ceylon Road.



Damage on Old Ceylon Road

FKG Civil Pty Ltd (FKG) has been awarded the contract to undertake reconstruction works.

Reconstruction will include:

- excavation
- constructing a cut-off drain
- constructing a retaining wall
- reinstating table drain adjoining the road
- reconstructing road pavement.

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Construction timing

Site establishment and construction will start in February 2024. Construction will take about four months, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Traffic & community impacts

Road closure and detour

Due to the confined working area and extensive repairs required, a short section of Old Ceylon Road near number 130 must be fully closed for the duration of works. This is to ensure the safety of workers and road users.

Detours will be in place, with motorists detoured via Cooroy-Belli Creek Road north of the work site and via Eumundi-Kenilworth Road. Please refer to the map illustrating the closure and detour options.

Work hours

Construction will generally be completed between Monday and Saturday, 7am-6pm.

Audible noise and dust

Audible noise and possible dust from construction activities and heavy machinery may be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during work hours.

Access changes

FKG will liaise with residents if access to properties will be impacted at any time during works.
