# Black Mountain, Cooroy-Belli Creek Road

## **Project update**

The 2022 flooding event caused damage at several locations on Cooroy-Belli Creek Road.

Civil Mining & Construction Pty Ltd (CMC) has been awarded the contract to undertake works adjacent to 673 and 705 Cooroy-Belli Creek Road.

Reconstruction will include:

- excavation and removal of unsuitable materials
- bored piles and soil anchors
- retaining walls
- drainage works
- rock scour protection
- pavement reconstruction and sealing
- installation of guardrail.

These works will help provide long-term stabilisation of the road.

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

### **Construction timing**

Site establishment and construction will start in February 2024. Construction will take about four months, weather and construction conditions permitting.

### **Traffic and community impacts**

#### Road closure and detour

Due to the confined working area, this section of Cooroy-Belli Creek Road must be fully closed during work hours to ensure the safety of motorists and workers.

Detours will be in place, with motorists detoured via Lawnville Road and Cooroy-Belli Creek Road. Please refer to the map illustrating the closure and detour options. The road will be open to one lane under traffic control outside work hours.

Other reconstruction projects are also starting across the hinterland. Motorists are reminded to drive to the changed conditions and follow signage.

#### Work hours

Construction will generally be completed between Monday and Saturday, 6am-6pm.

#### Audible noise and vibration

Audible noise and vibration from construction activities, such as piling, can be expected.

Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement on heavy machinery and will be used during work hours.

We acknowledge the significant disruption along Cooroy-Belli Creek Road arising from recent bridge renewal and these stormwaters repairs and thank you for your ongoing patience while Council maintains and repairs critical hinterland assets.
