Ridgewood, Happy Jack Creek Road

Project update

The 2022 flooding event caused landslide damage on Happy Jack Creek Road, Ridgewood.

FKG Civil Pty Ltd (FKG) has been awarded the contract to undertake reconstruction works.

Reconstruction will include:

- relocation of services
- clearing and grubbing
- pilina
- constructing a block wall
- culvert and drainage works
- rock fill batter
- reconstructing road.

The flood recovery effort for Noosa Council is jointly funded by the Commonwealth-State Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangements.

Construction timing

Construction will be completed between February and May 2024, weather and construction conditions permitting.

Traffic and community impacts

Road closure and detour

Due to the confined working area, this section of Happy Jack Creek Road must be fully closed for the duration of works. This is to ensure the safety of workers and road users.

Detours will be in place, with motorists detoured via Cooroy-Belli Creek Road and Kenilworth-Skyring Creek Road. Please refer to the map illustrating the closure and detour options.

Other reconstruction projects are also starting across the hinterland. Motorists are reminded to drive to the changed conditions and follow signage.

Work hours

Construction will generally be completed between Monday and Saturday, 7am-6pm.

Audible noise and dust

Audible noise and possible dust from construction activities and heavy machinery may be expected. Reversing beepers and flashing lights are a safety requirement and will be used during work hours.
