

Noosa's subtropical climate means sunny days and mild temperatures, averaging 24 degrees Celsius - perfect for healthy living and outdoor activities.

It's easy to get around...

National parks, beaches, shopping and restaurants are within walking distance or a short bike ride from the local villages of Noosa Junction, Sunrise Beach, Peregian Beach, and Tewantin, where most locals live . A little further afield, the hinterland towns of Cooroy and Pomona are accessible by the local bus services or private vehicles.

Noosa's easy to use and efficient public transport, is a popular choice with students, with frequent stops all along the Sunshine Coast. Also popular are bicycles and scooters which can be bought or hired locally.

For foodies...

Noosa is a renowned culinary destination, featuring local produce, talented chefs and award-winning restaurants. On the menu you'll find a wide array of flavours from all over the world. Noosa's food culture and hospitality industry is fuelled by prestigious Food and Wine events and demand from local and international tourists. Aspiring students can connect and learn from some of the industry's most prominent leaders.

For nature lovers...

Noosa is an internationally protected biosphere reserve, teeming with flora and fauna and home to endangered species, dolphins and sea turtles. Recognized by United Nations Education, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO), it encompasses 4,000 + hectares of land from the beautiful coastal walks and world surfing reserve all the way to Lake Weyba and the Noosa Everglades. Highlights include:

- Noosa Everglades 60 kilometers pristine, wetlands, mangroves and camping areas
- Double Island Point Beach Camping and 4WD in the Great Sandy National Park
- 15 kilometres of walking trails amidst the Noosa National Park
- · Hiking options include nearby Mt. Coolum or Mt. Pomona
- Noosa Hinterland waterfalls
- Nearby Australia Zoo, established by the late Steve Irwin, is a world-leader in animal conservation, providing a safe sanctuary for over 1,200 animals, advocating for and protecting wildlife and their habitat.

Noosa is situated along the whale migration highway. From July to September the coast is alive with the majestic beauty of the friendly giants of the sea, making their annual migration.

PATH TO A VISA

Compared to many countries, it can be quite straight-forward to get a Visa to study in Australia if you do your homework!.

To apply for an Australian student visa, you'll need to:

- Show a Confirmation of Enrolment at an Australian University
- Prove you have enough financial resources for study fees, living costs and departure
- Show a certificate that proves your English skills
- · Provide proof of insurances, like health and liability.
