Commercial Loading Zones

The only motor vehicles which are permitted to park within commercial loading zones, are motor vehicles defined as meeting the criteria as 'commercial vehicles'. Even if you are using a vehicle for a commercial purpose, without commercial identification or being of a

commercial vehicle type, you cannot utilise commercial vehicle-only Loading Zones.

A Commercial Loading Zone is identified by signs containing the conditions to park including the time limit these zones can only be used by vehicles that meet the following criteria, all other vehicles are prohibited:

- Any vehicle constructed, fitted or equipped to carry goods, excluding a sedan, wagon or motor bike or
- Any vehicle displaying a commercial vehicle identification label in accordance with the requirements of this subordinate local law, or
- Any vehicle displaying a commercial vehicle identification label issued by another local government.

Commercial vehicle identification label – for the purpose of this Subordinate Local Law the definition of a commercial vehicle identification label mentioned in section 8(1) of the authorising local law shall also include – 'a sign either permanent or magnetic (supplied by the user) that is attached to both the driver and front passenger doors on a vehicle indicating the business name and telephone contact number, with a minimum size of $300 \text{mm} \times 200 \text{mm}$ '.

My vehicle is registered/insured as Commercial

Without the required commercial identification described above, it is immaterial that your vehicle is registered as Commercial or the vehicle in question was being used for a commercial purpose.
