Accessible Public Toilets / Amenities Facility, Noosaville

Project summary

Noosa Council has received funding to build an accredited Public Amenities facility at Quota Park, Gympie Terrace in Noosaville. This new facility is designed to provide safe, dignified, and inclusive bathroom amenities for people with high support needs and their carers.

In addition to the Changing Places facility, the amenities block will also include general public toilets and showers, making it a valuable asset for the broader community and visitors to the foreshore. This project reinforces Council's commitment to making our public spaces more accessible, inclusive, and family-friendly.

We've listened!

This project will deliver on community feedback received during the development of the Noosaville Foreshore Infrastructure Master Plan, where residents and visitors expressed a strong desire for much-needed public toilets between Pirate Park and the tennis courts.

Council is also engaging closely with key disability advocates and support groups, including Spinal Life Australia, Sunshine Butterflies, and other end users. Their input is instrumental in guiding the placement and design of the facility to ensure it meets the needs of those who will benefit from it most.

Scope of works

The project involves the construction of a purpose-built amenities block that includes:

- Achieve high quality design consistent with Noosa Design Principles befitting the special place of the foreshore.
- A Changing Places accredited facility with an adult-sized change table, ceiling hoist, peninsula toilet, and privacy screen.
- General public toilet facilities to complement the existing amenities in the area.
- Landscaping and improved pathway connectivity for easy access.
- Seating and external showers to create a civic edge for the amenities
- Signage and wayfinding updates to highlight accessible features.
- New footpath link providing access to PWD carparks

Timing

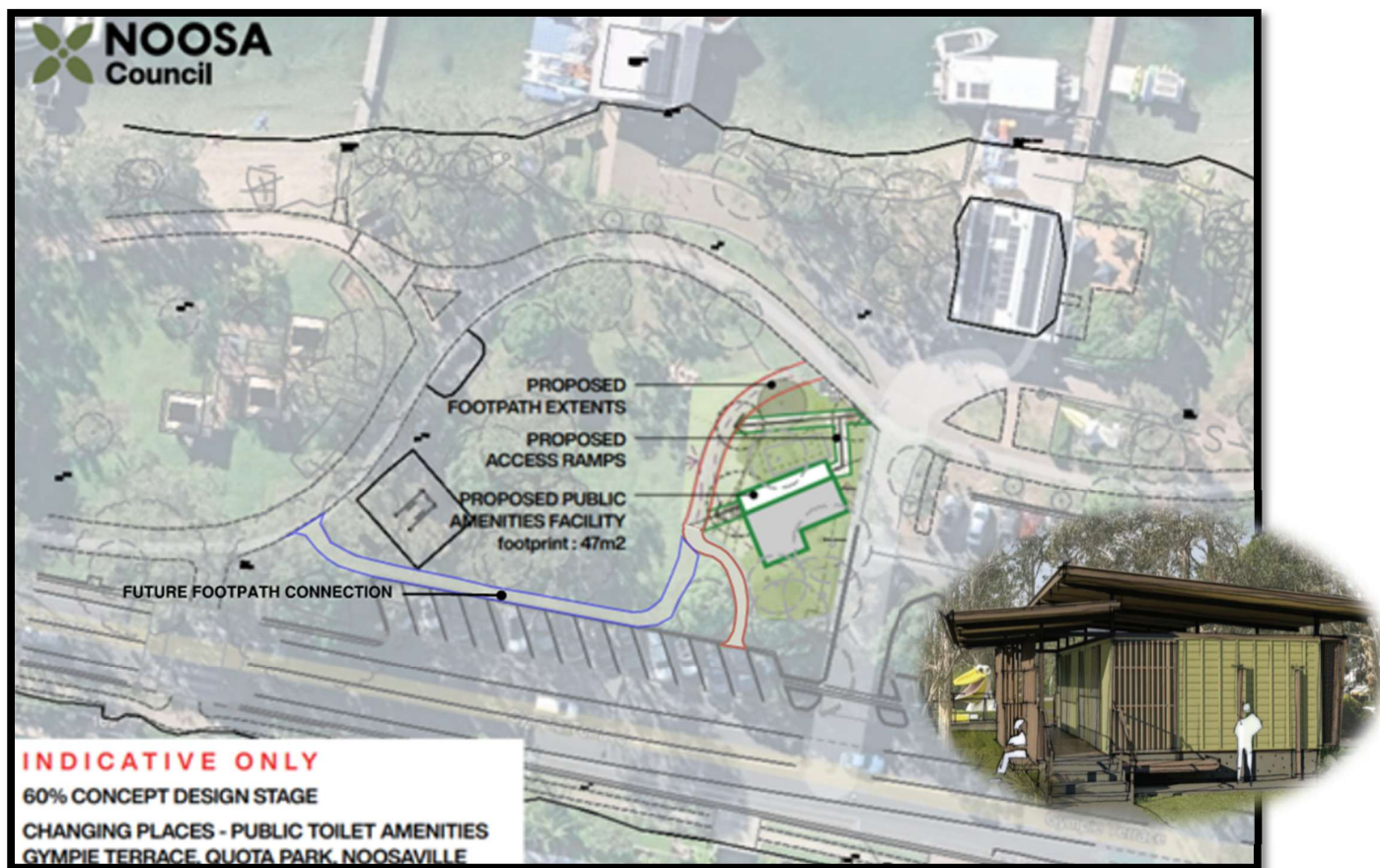
- Concept design – in progress
