
William Steet Pathway Upgrade, Tewantin

Project Summary

Noosa Council is upgrading the pedestrian pathway network along William Street, Tewantin, to improve connectivity within the local active transport network.

Works include the construction of approximately 120 metres of new concrete pathway and the renewal of 60 metres of existing pathway along William Street. These upgrades will improve accessibility and provide safer, more connected links for residents and visitors.

The project forms part of Council's ongoing commitment to improving active transport infrastructure and enhancing community safety.

Scope of Work

The works include:

- Replacing the existing deteriorated asphalt pathway through Jacaranda Park with a new 2m-wide concrete pathway.
- Constructing a new 2m-wide concrete pathway connecting John Street to Jacaranda Park.
- Landscaping and reinstatement of areas disturbed during construction.

Timing

Construction is scheduled to commence on **Monday 22 June 2026** and is expected to be completed by **late July 2026**, weather permitting.

Works will occur Monday to Friday between 6:30am and 5:00pm, with no weekend works planned.

Community Impacts

During construction, residents may notice:

- Temporary pathway closures.
- Minor noise, dust and increased construction vehicle movements.

Council and the contractor will work closely to minimise disruption and maintain safe access wherever possible.

Traffic Impacts

To safely complete the works, the following traffic changes may be required during work hours:

- Shoulder closures and occasional one-way traffic conditions.
- Traffic controllers and signage to assist residents, visitors and service vehicles.

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Two-way traffic will be restored outside work hours and on weekends. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Noise Impacts

Some construction noise is expected during these works. The project team will take reasonable steps to minimise impacts and thanks the community for its patience and understanding while these important upgrades are completed.

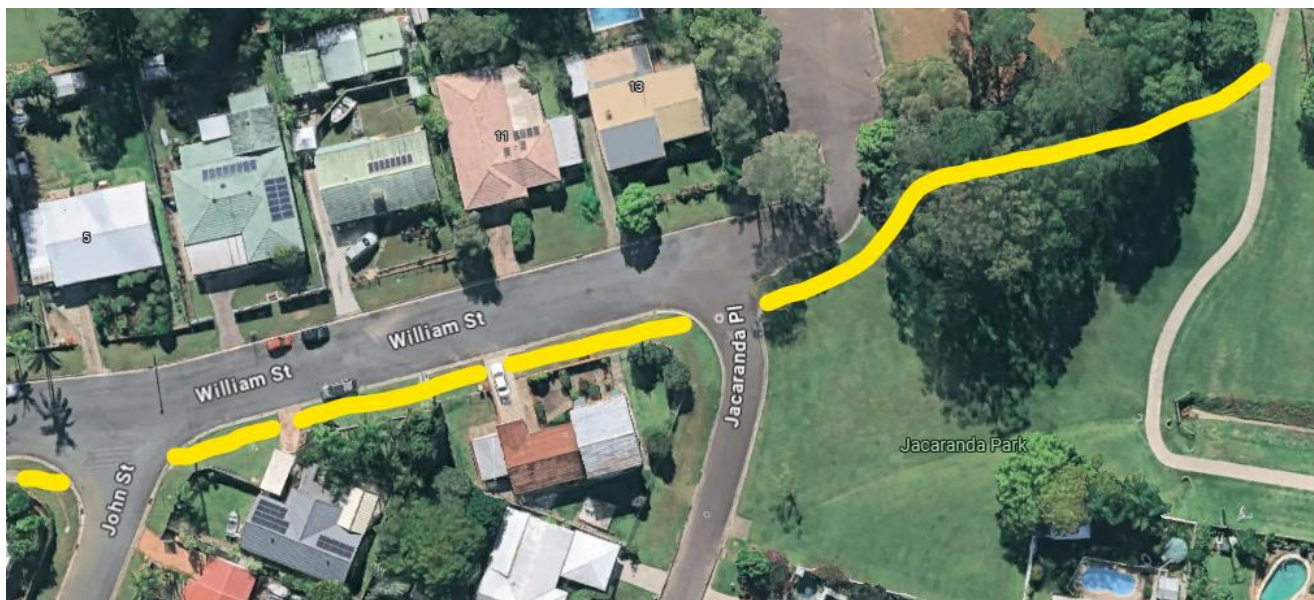


IMAGE: Extent of work at William St, Tewantin

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
