Noosaville, Noosa Waters – Canal Cleaning Works

Project summary

Contractors will soon commence canal cleaning works within Noosa Waters to remove floating algae debris.

Duration of work

Work is scheduled to commence on Monday, 20th October with completion expected by Friday, 24th October 2025, subject to weather, contractor availability and site conditions. Any changes or updates to the above timeframes will be published on the Council website.

The work will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm.

Disruptions to marine navigation and the public

Every effort will be made to minimise the impact, on traffic and the public, however some canal access may be periodically impacted while contractors work to remove debris. The Noosa Waters lock will remain open.

Further information

Algae growth is typical for this time of year and is influenced by seasonal conditions, including warmer temperatures and elevated nutrient levels from stormwater discharge and residential runoff (e.g. fertilisers and grass clippings). Algae growth generally persists for 4 - 6 weeks before naturally declining.

Community concern has understandably been heightened this year due to the canal pumping system being offline for a period, which reduced water circulation and flushing.
