Peregian Beach, David Low Way and Heron Street Roundabout – Tree Planting Works

Project summary

Contractors will soon commence tree planting works in the David Low Way and Heron Street roundabout.

Work will include replacement planting of pandanus tree/s in the roundabout.

Duration of work

Work is scheduled to commence on Wednesday, 16 September 2026 with completion expected by Wednesday, 16 September 2026, subject to weather, contractor availability and site conditions.

The work will be undertaken during the day between the hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm.
