Sunshine Beach, Ferguson St – Vegetation Management Works

Project summary

Contractors will soon commence vegetation management works within the reserve behind the Ferguson Street and Douglas Street properties.

Works will include the removal of dead trees, trees with significant structural defects, trees growing into or in contact with buildings or other structures, and undesirable non-native species, including Golden Cane Palms and Mock Orange.

Going forward, residents with direct access to the reserve are encouraged to mow or snip grass and weeds adjacent to their properties, similar to the road frontages.

Tree management within the reserve will continue to be undertaken by Council as required. No planting or disposal of green waste is permitted in the reserve.

Duration of work

Work is scheduled to commence on Monday, 21 September 2026 with completion expected by Thursday, 24 September 2026, subject to weather, contractor availability and site conditions.

Any changes or updates to the above timeframes will be published on the Council website.

The work will be undertaken between the hours of 7am and 5pm.

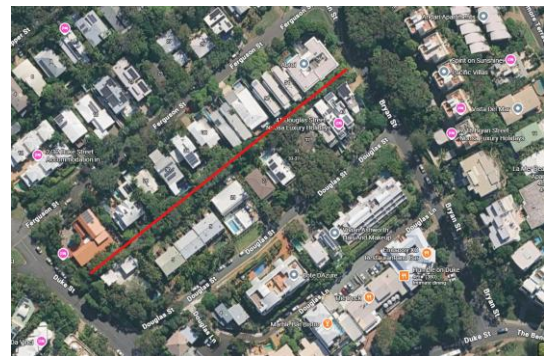
Disruptions to the public
