Nandroya Road, Cooroy

Noosa Council would like to update the community about the status of investigations into repairing landslide damage on Nandroya Road.

A submission has now been made to the Queensland Reconstruction Authority (QRA) to secure funding to repair the damage. The QRA administers funding for disaster reconstruction across Queensland.

Investigations into repair options and preparing the submission do take time, and we appreciate the community's ongoing patience and cooperation.

Pending QRA approval, Council is aiming to start construction when the dry season starts in 2026.

Traffic management

Ongoing engineering assessments have confirmed single-lane operation continues to be the safest option for Nandroya Road.

Motorists are reminded the temporary traffic signals and reduced speed limits are place for driver safety.

Managing compliance with speed limits and temporary traffic signals can be challenging. Queensland Police Service has jurisdiction over non-compliance with the road rules.
