## Sunshine Creek embankment stabilisation, Sunrise Beach

### Unauthorised site access

Unauthorised access to the construction site near Ross Crescent continues to be a significant concern for Noosa Council and the construction contractor.

We again remind the community this area is a worksite. Access is restricted to authorised persons only. Conditions on the site are constantly changing, with multiple hazards and potential risks for pedestrians.

In addition to people unlawfully entering the site, there have also been repeated incidents of vandalism.

Reports have now been filed with Queensland Police Service (QPS) about the damage that has occurred.

### What we are doing

We are introducing the following measures to help encourage compliance:

- additional fencing
- more warning signage
- on-site spotters during work hours
- CCTV cameras to capture photographs and footage of offenders
- ongoing liaison with QPS.

In addition to safety concerns, work stoppages are delaying progress. The project is also incurring additional costs for new fencing and surveillance.

The longer it takes to resolve this issue, the longer the construction will take and the pedestrian pathway will remain closed.

### How you can help

We are asking for the community's co-operation to not enter the construction site.

Please remember:

- Any location beyond the fence is considered the worksite.
- Do not go beyond the fence unless you are an authorised person.
